### **NOW is the time for NutriSoil!**

Many regions have welcomed the recent rainfall which has moistened the soils and initiated some upwards movement in plants. This signifies the best time to apply NutriSoil for rapid foliar uptake of plant available nutrients and stimulation of essential organisms for achieving fertile soil.

For orchardists, foliar application late summer / early autumn while leaves are still vital will be highly beneficial for nutrient uptake.

Innoculation of seeds in NutriSoil concentrate prior to planting assists early germination.

### **Time to consider Soil Life**

With fertilizer prices going through the roof, it couldn't be more timely to consider soil health as an alternative to expensive input farming. Most soils have a bank of locked up nutrients that cannot be utilized without the ability to convert them into a plant available form. This is the essence of biological farming.
