tools which has seen them transition into a regenerative farming system. The Whitings are basically synthetic input free except for spot spraying of thistles and blackberries. During their transition the Whitings have been using NutriSoil as a foliar application on their pastures, they will now move to using NutriSoil as a seed inoculant as their soil health has improved so greatly the growing plants can readily access all they need from the soil for

It was wonderful to be able to bring agroecologist David Hardwick to the April BFR who explained the role of soil type, soil structure and soil fertility in a healthy production system. David's presentations are always entertaining and educational, particularly the best soil in show competition which everyone loves. We were fortunate enough to have a SoilKee demonstration from



Niels and Jamie Olsen, SoilKee provides the option of sowing directly into pasture or existing cover crops. SoilKee works best in higher rainfall regions and allows newly sown plants to utilise nutrients provided by the existing plants. The event was well attended with around 40 participants from as far away as Gippsland and South Australia.

Albury BFR

NutriSoil had the pleasure of hosting the Albury BFR on May 27 here at our worm farm and warehouse in Baranduda. Again, we secured the services of agroecologist David Hardwick to discuss the role of soil type and soil structure in addressing soil fertility. David ran a best soil in show competition and explains the crucial part microbes play in soil and plant health.

Our own Nakala Maddock explained how everything NutriSoil does ties into the company's vision of empowering farmers to grow nutrient dense food. Nakala was able to describe how to best use NutriSoil and what it contains, the benefits of using the product to farm profit margins and the advantages to overall human health. Ectol was at the event to speak about their organic crop and pasture growth products, and there was a SoilKee demonstration on site.



The BFR concluded with an interview with Ray and Whyatt Snell who operate Huon Ag Services, a 1000 acre property in Wodonga. The Snells began their regenerative agriculture journey about three years ago due to ongoing problems with hard soils and heliotrope proliferation.

Since reducing their synthetic inputs and transitioning to biological products the Snells have noticed a number of changes in their grazing enterprise. Their cattle have increased the diversity of what they graze and as a result they no longer slash phalaris pastures. During summer their cattle have maintained weight gain grazing summer grasses like kikuyu, which are now more palatable to the cattle.

Quality Control

In early May Maria from Microbe Labs Australia spent three days with us at our worm farm and production site in Baranduda. Microbe Labs have been employed by NutriSoil to help establish a quality control system specific to vermiculture, which will become a world first!

NutriSoil take pride in providing a quality

product to our customers, we are establishing this new quality control system to ensure we can provide consistency with every batch we distribute from our warehouse. Working with a naturally biological system has variabilities, however we have identified key control points in our production process which will allow us to test and identify any potential hazards to ensure we continue to supply a consistent product.
